
## Annual Report 2023-24

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


## Performing Arts Department



What makes KSV so special is its unwavering commitment to the performing arts. As a performing arts school, our comprehensive approach ensures that every student has the opportunity to explore and develop their artistic abilities, fostering creativity, discipline, and a deep appreciation for cultural heritage.

Each weekday morning, our students dedicate an hour to honing their chosen art form, immersing themselves in practice and refinement. Following this, from 8:30 am to 11:15 am, five days a week, students engage in focused performing arts classes, ensuring they receive ample time to develop their skills.

### Structured Programs

To accommodate the diverse artistic interests of our students, we have designed two tracks: Elementary Classes for students in 1st to 4th standards, and Regular Classes for those in 5th to 10th standards.

Our Elementary program introduces young students to the fundamentals of the Indian classical arts, including Hindustani classical music, Kathak dance, and engaging creative activities that stimulate their curiosity and love for the arts.

In the Regular Classes, they are given the chance to specialise further, choosing from disciplines such as vocal music, tabla, sitar, violin, and drama. Many opt to pursue two art forms, dedicating extra practice hours in the evenings, four times a week. This intensive training prepares them for both internal and external performances, ensuring they reach their highest potential.



#### Manch Pradarshan

Manch Pradarshan is a central element of our performing arts program, providing students with a weekly program to present their progress and talents.

This event encourages students from all age groups to step onto the stage and perform in front of their peers, teachers, and the entire school community.

The atmosphere is both supportive and inspiring, helping students build the confidence, self-expression, and stage presence that are essential to their artistic growth.

### Performing Arts Examination

The evaluation of performing arts is integral to our commitment to nurturing students' artistic growth. We employ a continuous assessment system where teachers regularly evaluate students' progress in their performing arts classes.

For students in the 5th standard and above, we conduct an annual internal performing arts examination. This provides students with valuable feedback on their progress and helps them refine their skills.

This year, we focused on internal examinations due to ongoing adjustments in external testing conditions. We are pleased to report a 100% pass rate in these internal examinations, reflecting the dedication and talent of our students.

### EdelGive Program

### Nurturing Musical Heritage with the Indian Foundation for the Arts

In partnership with the Indian Foundation for the Arts (IFA), KSV embarked on a comprehensive and immersive project, guiding students through the rich heritage of classical instrument craftsmanship in Miraj, a cultural gem in Maharashtra. This initiative, aimed at fostering a deep appreciation for traditional Indian music and its instruments, unfolded in four distinct phases over the course of the year.

The journey began with an in-depth introduction to classical instruments such as the sitar, tanpura, and tabla. Students explored the history and evolution of these instruments, learning about their construction, various forms, and the music theory that underpins their use.

The second phase took students directly to Miraj, a hub of instrumentmaking for centuries. Here, they observed firsthand the artistry involved in crafting these instruments, from material selection to assembly. The artisans shared their stories, shedding light on the challenges posed by modern electronic alternatives.

Following the field visit, KSV hosted a hands-on workshop led by renowned vocal and sitar artists. Students had the opportunity to practice playing the instruments, learning fundamental techniques and understanding how these instruments are used in Raag Sangeet. # Students' Welfare Department

### Hostels

Our campus features eight residential hostels, specifically designed for boys and girls. Each hostel accommodates approximately 25 students, categorized into Small, Medium, Big, and Senior. To ensure the well-being of our students outside of academic activities, each hostel is overseen by two dedicated wardens who provide attentive care and support.









### Nutritional Programs

Nutrition plays a pivotal role in our welfare program, forming the foundation for the overall well-being of our students. Our dedicated kitchen staff prepare and serve three wholesome, nutritious South Indian vegetarian meals every day. These meals provide a balanced diet, incorporating essential nutrients that promote not only physical health but also cognitive development and mental well-being.

Our efforts extend beyond mere sustenance. By fostering healthy eating habits and ensuring a well-rounded diet, we contribute to the holistic development of our students, enabling them to thrive both physically and mentally. This comprehensive approach to nutrition supports their educational journey, helping them to perform at their best in all areas of life.



### Healthcare Services

Healthcare is another critical aspect of our welfare program. Our oncampus infirmary is staffed by a dedicated team who ensure all essential basic medical needs are met. Additionally, during the year, we welcomed two volunteer nurses for a short-term period, who provided valuable assistance.

For more complex health issues, we have established partnerships with local hospitals, including SDM College of Dental Sciences and Vivekanand General Hospital, Hubli. This comprehensive approach ensures prompt and effective care for our students, staff, and volunteers.

#### **Hostel Construction**

In March, we proudly completed two new hostels on the KSV campus, made possible by the generous support of Danfoss Power Solutions. These new facilities provide safe and comfortable accommodations for 58 students, significantly improving their well-being and daily lives.

The Senior Girls Hostel now houses 28 girls from the 9th and 10th standards and those pursuing higher education, while the Small Boys Hostel accommodates 30 boys from the 1st and 2nd standards. Both hostels offer improved living conditions, including enhanced bathroom facilities and adjacent rooms for wardens, ensuring a supportive environment for our students' growth and academic success.

Sustainability was at the heart of this project, with the hostels constructed using locally sourced materials such as stone, clay, and timber. The eco-friendly design, including wooden-tiled roofs, helps keep the buildings cool and in harmony with the natural surroundings of our campus.

This project was a collaborative effort, with close coordination between our staff, contractors, and volunteers. While challenges arose, we learned valuable lessons along the way, making this construction effort a great success.





#### **Nutritious support**

Danfoss continues to provide essential support by sponsoring one nutritious meal per day for all KSV students throughout the year. This contribution plays a crucial role in ensuring that each student receives a the proper nutrition they need daily fostering heir health, well-being, and enhancing their ability to learn and thrive.



## The Role of the EdelGive Foundation in our Arts Journey

Moreover, all KSV College students pursuing Performing Arts have received financial support for their studies, thanks to the contributions from the EdelGive Foundation. ## Bridging the Learning Gap with SELCO Foundation

In partnership with SELCO Foundation, we have been launching a series of targeted remedial classes to address the academic challenges faced by our students due to COVID-19.

These classes have been tailored to meet the individual needs of each student, identified through a baseline study.

Scheduled from May to November 2023, the project aims to support students in regaining their academic abilities through various interventions, including peer-to-peer and small group sessions, as well as one-on-one teaching.

Through this collaborative effort, we aim to not only enhance the academic skills of our students but also boost their confidence and motivation to learn. The support from SELCO Foundation has been invaluable, enabling us to create a nurturing environment where students can thrive academically and overcome the setbacks caused by the pandemic.





## Sponsorship
